In honor of Women's History Month, in March, the Main Library will exhibit Picturing Women Inventors, a series of eight posters that explore the inventions of 19 highly accomplished American women. Astronauts, computer pioneers, and businesswomen join athletes, engineers, and even teenagers in this remarkable group of inventors.
